Please bring a healthy breakfast snack to share and we will provide fruit and coffee/tea (for adults).

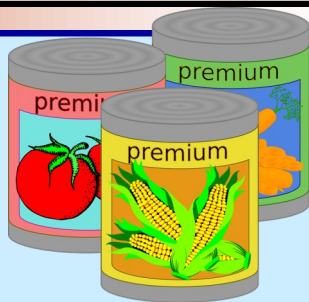
Please bring your own safety cup/mug if you would like a hot drink. For Health and safety reasons we cannot serve coffee in open cups. We look forward to seeing you all there!
